Theatre Academy Classes

Crowd Pleasers (ages 3-5)

This fun and exciting class is a wonderful way to introduce our youngest performers to the magical world of musical theatre. They will learn basics in music, acting, and dance as well as team work and confidence building through fun games and exercises.

Curtains Rising (ages 5-7)

For the kids at home that can't stop singing and dancing. This class introduces performers to stage directions, improvisation, choreography, song and scene study using fun games and activities. Set the Stage I (ages 8-13)
